Competition

FLEXIBLE DRAWS

The Internationaux Jeunes du Grand Est are a team competition. Each team shall consist of 4 players minimum and 12 players maximum. Additional entries are possible.

Groups shall be defined by the number of players.

Only the teams that shall be represented in at least 6 different draws may appear in the team challenge. Teams shall be ranked according to the six best results in different draws.

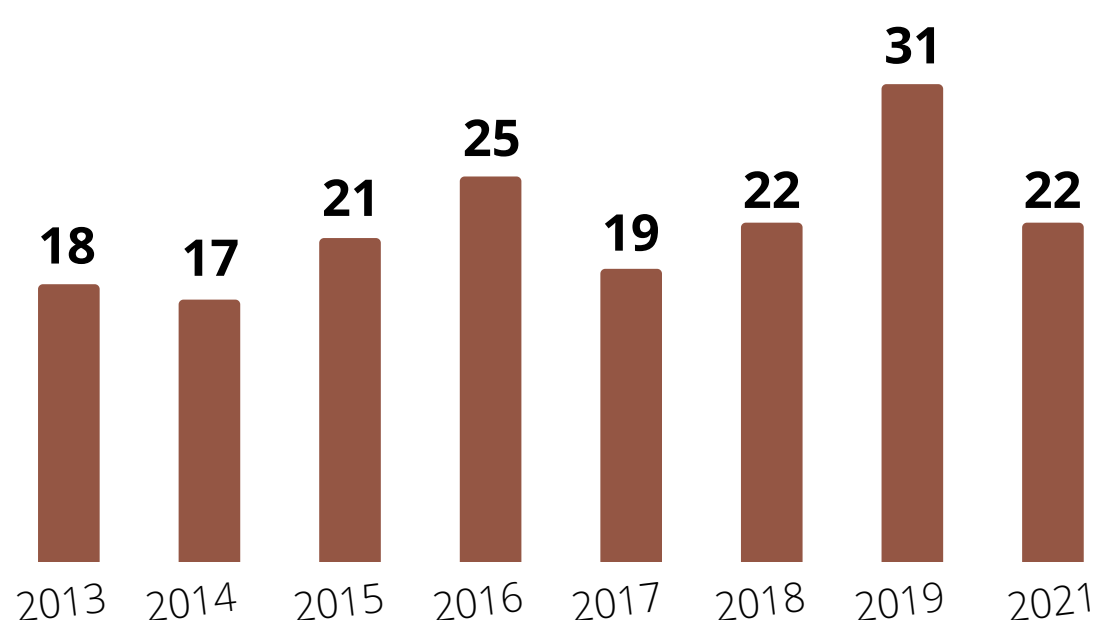

SCHEDULE

The competition starts on **Saturday** around **1:30.pm** and ends on **Sunday** around **5.pm**.
Possibility for delegations to train from 10.am on Saturday.

UMPIRING

Official umpires for all matches of the Internationaux Jeunes du Grand Est.
It is required that each delegation provides an umpire who will be available to the Referee during the competition.

PACKAGE A

In a collective and renovated residential school, near the venue, with rooms of 3 or 4 persons and privative toilets and bathroom, for a cost of 72€ per person.

Extra charge for a single room: 25€.

PACKAGE B

In a three-star hotel, with rooms of 2 persons or more, for a cost of 87€ per person.

Extra charge for a single room: 35€.

These packages include Saturday dinner, the night from Saturday to Sunday, breakfast and Sunday lunch.

Meals are served inside the venue and breakfast at the accommodation place. Saturday lunch can be reserved at a charge of 13€ per person.

The entry fees for the delegations who do not want to pay overnight charge shall be 30€ per player.
