Competition

FLEXIBLE DRAWS

The Internationaux Jeunes du Grand Est are a team competition. Each team shall consist of 4 players minimum and 12 players maximum. Additional entries are possible.

Groups shall be defined by the number of players.

Only the teams that shall be represented in at least 6 different draws may appear in the team challenge. Teams shall be ranked according to the six best results in different draws.

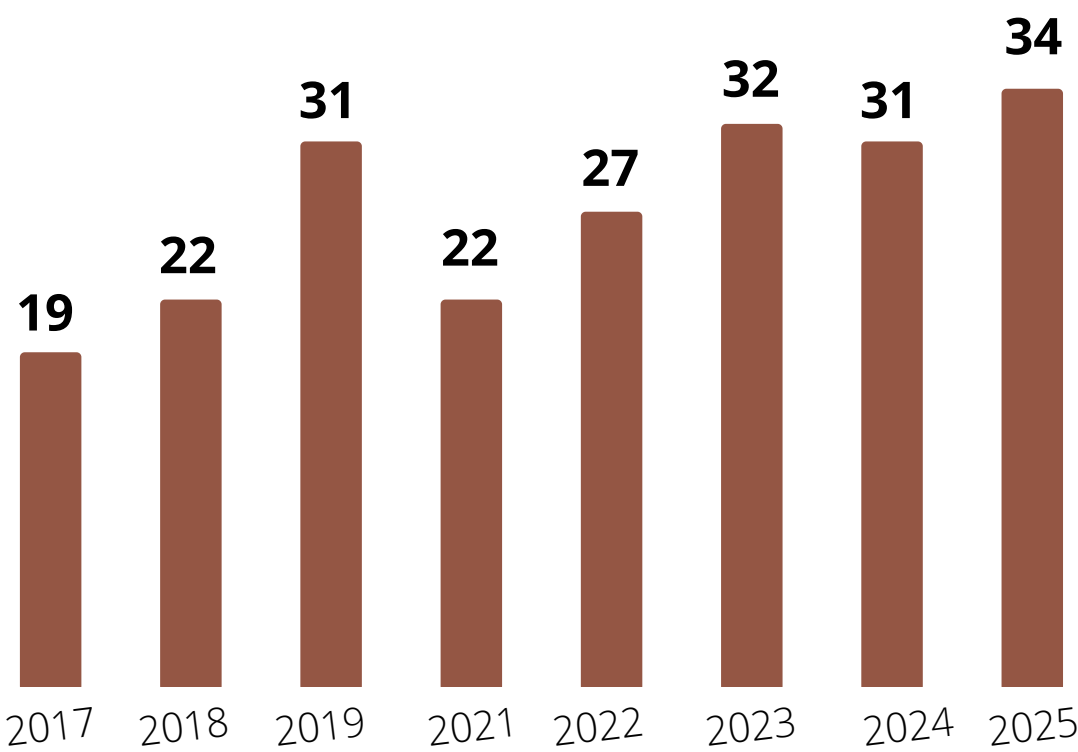

SCHEDULE

The competition starts on **Saturday** around 13h00 and ends on **Sunday** around 17h00.
Umpires metting on **Saturday** at 11h15.
Possibility for delegations to train from 10h00 on Saturday.

UMPIRING

Official umpires for all matches of the Internationaux Jeunes du Grand Est.
It is required that each delegation provides an umpire who will be available to the Referee during the competition.

PACKAGE A

Intended primarily for regional and departmental organisations.

In a collective residential school, near the venue (CFA) with rooms of 3 or 4 persons and privative toilets and bathroom, for a cost of **80€ per person**.
Rooms could be shared with another delegation.
Extra charge for a single room: 25€.

PACKAGE B

In a classical two or three-star hotel (Campanile, B and B, Enzo, Ibis Budget, etc) with rooms of 2 persons or more, for a cost of **95€ per person**.
Some hotels are in Pont-à-Mousson, others are in South Metz (20 min) or North Nancy (25 min).
Extra charge for a single room: 35€.

PACKAGE C

In a superior three-star hotel (Abbaye des Prémontrés, Hôtel du Parc, etc) with rooms of 2 persons or more, for a cost of **105€ per person**.
These hotels are in Pont-à-Mousson.
Extra charge for a single room: 45€.

We reserve the right to change the package you have chosen to another package if necessary (from A to B or from C to B).

These packages include **Saturday dinner, the night from Saturday to Sunday, breakfast and Sunday lunch**.
Meals are served inside the venue and breakfast at the accommodation place.

Saturday lunch can be reserved at a charge of 13€ per person.

Accomodation



If you arrive on the Friday evening, you can book the night form Friday to Saturday, with an extra cost of 25€/person in package A, 40€/person in package B and 50€/person in package C.

The entry fees for the delegations who do not want to benefit from our packages shall be **45€ per player** (free for coaches).
